

**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
FOR
MARTIN TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS, INC. 401(K) PLAN**

This is a summary of the annual report for the Martin Transportation Systems, Inc. 401(k) Plan, EIN 38-2842208, Plan No. 005, for the period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided through a trust fund. Plan Expenses were \$384,166. These expenses included \$379,801 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, (\$435) in certain deemed distributions of participant loans and \$4,800 in other expenses. A total of 1231 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$6,193,742 as of December 31, 2016, compared to \$5,152,703 as of January 1, 2016. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its assets of \$1,041,039. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$1,425,205 including employee contributions of \$771,546, employer contributions of \$226,263, rollover contributions of \$39,334, other income of \$6 and earnings from investments of \$388,056.
